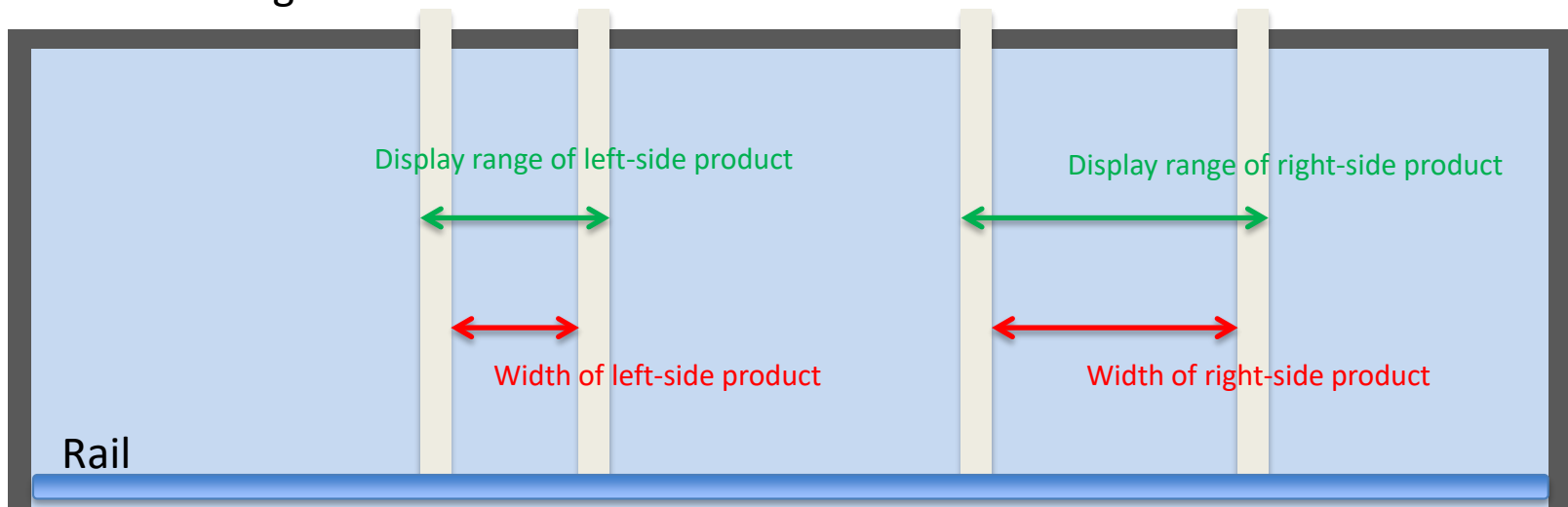


# Ruling the face up success/failure

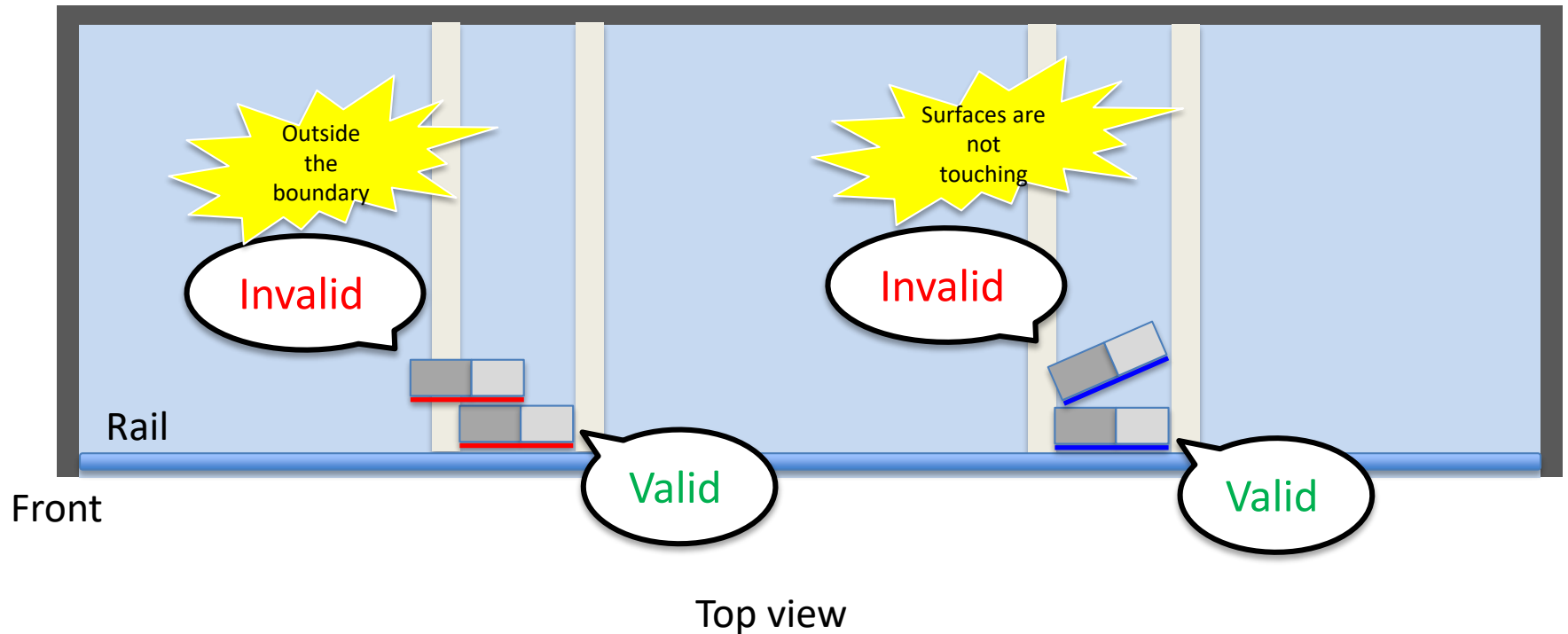
- Translucent tape (Scotch brand mending tape of 18mm wide) indicating the display target range of each product is affixed to the shelves.
- The left and right positions of the tape will be announced in the morning of the task's competition day.
- The inner spacing of the border (indicated by the red line  $\leftrightarrow$ ) is equal to the width of the target product.
- Each product must be placed completely within the outer boundary of the tape (within the area indicated by the green line  $\leftrightarrow$ ), a range equivalent to the width of the product plus 36mm.
- The first product must be in contact with the rail at a predetermined angle.
- The second and subsequent products must be in contact with the previous product at a predetermined angle.



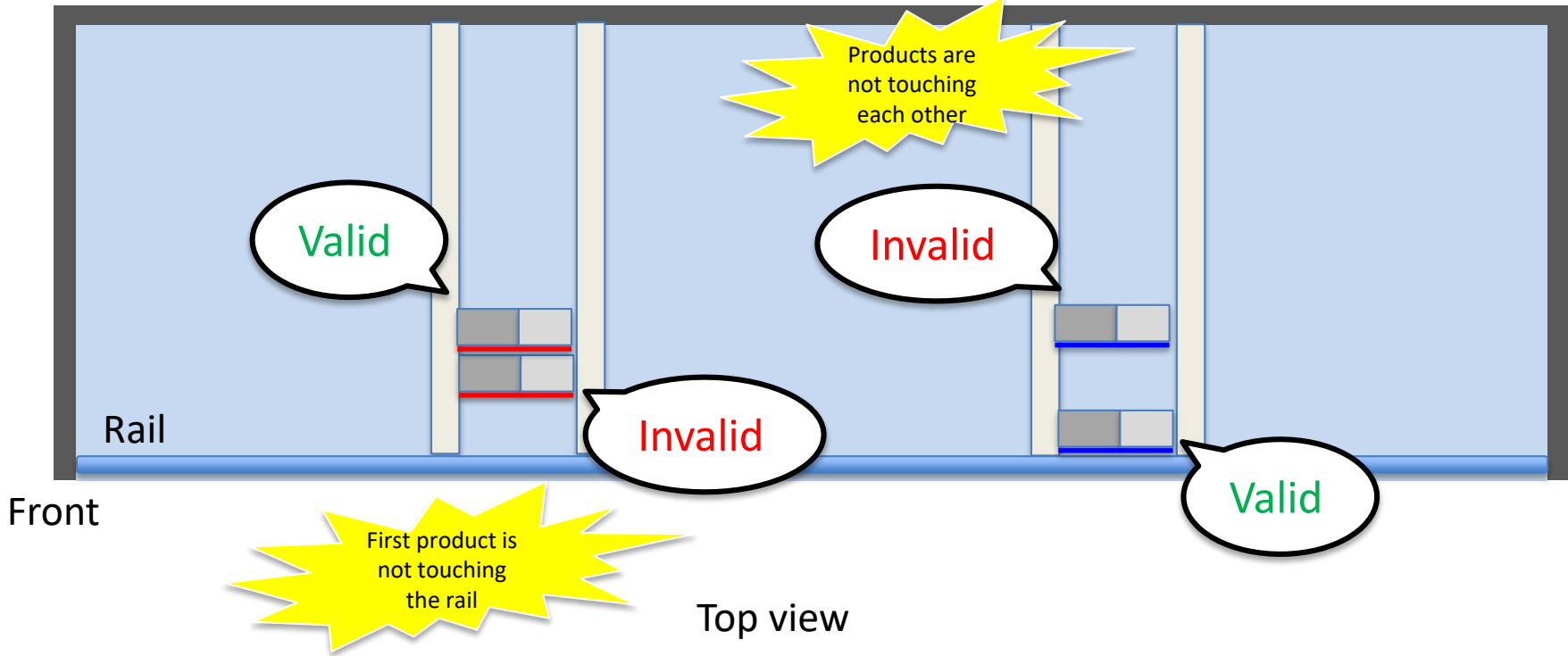

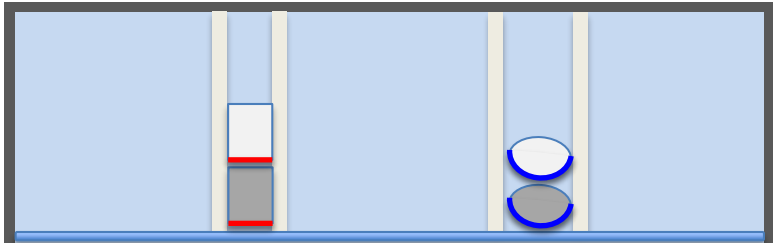
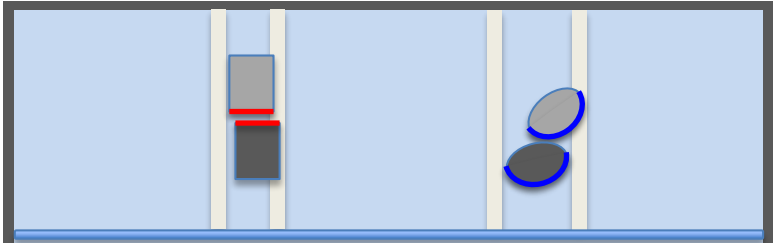


# Example of initial and target states

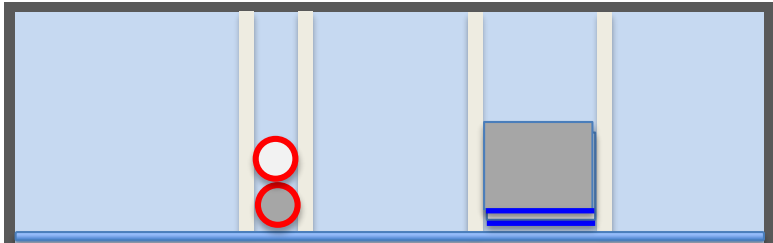
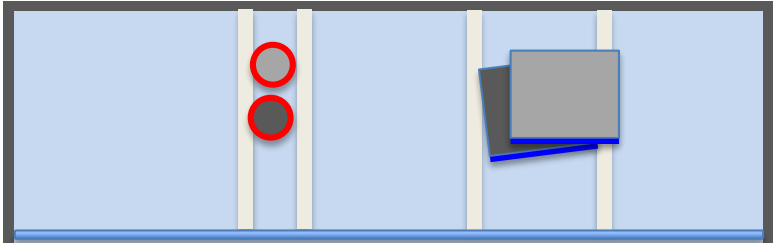
Top shelf
